Do I have to speak French?

No, you don't. Your work in the lab can be carried out in English. However if you're interested in learning some French and getting by more easily outside of working hours, a 2 to 4-hour French course is offered every week for all our international students. This course is free of charge and is held on the school's premises. Outings are also organized by the French club.
