



Call for papers for a special issue of International Journal of Healthcare Information Systems and Informatics

“Joint advances in Information Systems and Operational Research applied to Healthcare”

Many healthcare problems cross the traditional boundaries of information systems and operational research. For example, emergency services have organisational issues that could be addressed using methods and tools taken from both operational research (e.g. resource allocation, optimisation, simulation etc.) and from information systems (e.g. real time communication between different emergency care stakeholders). Researchers in IS and OR tend to constitute two different communities who rarely collaborate. However, an encouraging number of papers in the scientific programme of the ORAHS 2007 conference promote the benefit of cross-disciplinary work. This special issue aims to fill the gap in the literature by reporting on joint advances in information systems and operational research applied to healthcare. The focus of this special number is thus on papers which include both aspects of OR and IS applied to any topic within the healthcare domain.

When preparing your paper, you should follow the author guidelines (see below). All submitted papers will undergo the normal peer review process for any high quality journal.
